She loved cooking, gardening, reading, music, but most of all taking care of her family. She always sacrificed her needs for the family she loved, and kept an ever present eye on how “her boys” were doing.

Jane will be remembered for her caring and compassion, and for being an altruistic wife and mother. She was always there for the little league games, cub scout meetings, and orchestra concerts, but most of all, there was no guest that entered her household that left with an empty stomach. Her legendary command of the kitchen is where her creativity and kindness knew no-bounds. That will continue to be a lasting legacy within and outside of our family.

Jane loved her friends and cherished the time they spent together. She was a founding member of the GO SEMO Relay for Life team and helped raise \$78,000 to fight cancer. She spent countless hours dedicating time to comforting her friends on doctor visits to St. Louis, that they would rebrand as “girls trips”. She had a quiet strength and battled bravely against cancer.

She was preceded in death by her sister Cathy Crites. She is survived by her parents John and Velma Crites, her husband Mike, sons Chris (Lauren) and Robert and her two grandchildren Chase and Ryan.
