



## Franklin Delano Crites

August 7, 1938 - April 5, 2020

The beloved Franklin “Buster” Delano Crites, 81, of Jackson, Missouri lost his battle with Alzheimer’s but won his greatest victory Sunday, April 5, 2020 at The Villas of Jackson surrounded by his family.

He was born August 7, 1938 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri and was the youngest son of Oscar and Edith Crites. He married Jeanne Watson on December 26, 1959. They relocated to Carbondale, IL in 1961 where they raised their family.

Frank was a proud and dedicated family man. He was steadfast in his faith in God. He was a bit of a prankster and loved a good joke. The best jokes always brought bouts of his joyful wheezing laughter. He had a soft spot for dogs and occasionally cats (which includes the cat he couldn’t outrun on an evening jog). He held many jobs in his lifetime. He worked as a systems analyst for the Housing Department at Southern Illinois University until his retirement. He was an active member of Maple United Methodist Church and sang in the choir with his beautiful baritone voice. He was a Navy Veteran, Past Master of the Masonic Lodge, and a Hospice volunteer.

He is survived by his dedicated loving wife, Jeanne, his two sons, David (Laura) and Jeffery (Cindy) and his four granddaughters, Christine, Michelle, Kaitlyn and Rachel as well as several nieces and nephews.
