



Alan Edward "Bud" Reed

May 26, 1926 - September 21, 2015

Alan Edward (Bud) Reed, 89, of St. Louis, Mo, formerly of Cape Girardeau, died Monday, Sept. 21, 2015 at his home.

He was born May 26, 1926 in Cape Girardeau to Frank Edward and Yvette Opal Hunt Reed.

He and Linnette Maxine Wagner were married in 1948 at Piggott, Ark. She died Mar. 7, 2000.

He served in the United States Army from Jan. 1945 to Nov. 1946 serving in Japan. He was a member of the 152nd Airborne.

He was a welder by trade and worked for Missouri Dry Docks and Foundry for 15 years then for Mid-South Steel for 25 years. He retired in 1986. He moved to St. Louis in 1989.

He was an active member of Christian Fellowship Church of Lemay, Mo. and a former member of Red Star Baptist Church in Cape Girardeau. He was a life member of VFW Post 3838 of Cape Girardeau.

He is survived by a son, Randy Reed of St. Louis; two daughters, Sondra Summers of Cape Girardeau, Cynthia (Ron) Talbert of Cahokia, Il.; one

brother, Robert Reed of Cape Girardeau; one sister, Frankie Clippard of Benton, Ky.; two grandchildren; six great grandchildren; three great-great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, an infant daughter Brenda Sue, four sisters and twin sisters.

Visitation will be held Friday from 6 to 8 p.m. at Ford and Sons Mt. Auburn Chapel.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 10 a.m. at the funeral home with the Rev. Donny Ford officiating.

Burial will follow at Lorimier Cemetery in Cape Girardeau with full military honors.
