February 14, 1925 - July 2, 2016

Albert Calvin "Al" Hitt, 91, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Saturday, July 2, 2016 at his home.

He was born February 14, 1925 in Advance, Missouri to Albert Jackson and Nora Louise DeLapp Hitt.

He and Ella Allmon were married May 12, 1946 at Whitewater, Missouri. She preceded him in death in 1974. He later married Mary Steddom Goodman July 12, 1975 at Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Al served in the Army and Army Air Force as a paratrooper in World War II.

He first attended Southeast Missouri State and then received a degree from St. Louis College of Pharmacy. He worked as a pharmacist, but was hired as a pharmaceutical salesman for E. R. Squibb & Sons which became part of Bristol-Myers Squibb. He eventually returned to work as a pharmacist for Walmart and other pharmacies and worked until 87 years of age.

He was a member of Breakfast Optimist Club, SEMO Booster Club, and Cape County Pharmacist Association. He was also a member of Bethany Baptist Church. He was very active in his church and was a Sunday School Teacher.

Survivors include his wife, Mary Hitt of Cape Girardeau; two daughters, Donna Lynn Osiecki of Saint Charles, Rhonda Ellen Rumbaugh of State College, Pennsylvania; two stepsons, Scott Goodman of Saint Charles, Missouri and David Goodman of Longmont, Colorado; stepdaughter, Lisa Laffoon of Malawi, Africa; 10 grandchildren, Rachel Corrigan, Mike, Doug, and Craig Rumbaugh, Meg and John Paul Calvin Goodman, Anna Marie, Nathanel, Joel and Jeremiah Laffoon.

He was preceded in death by his parents; first wife; daughter, Marcia Hitt; brothers, Eugene, Waldo, Everett, and Lowell Hitt; sisters, Lorene Lusher, Lenore Hitt, Anne Wood and Ila Marshall.
