Allen Edward Lane, 69, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Tuesday, April 8, 2025 at Jackson Manor.

He was born August 9, 1955 to Doyle Luckey and JoAnn Barber Lane.

He and Diane Marie French were married September 25, 1982 at Brazeau, Missouri. She preceded him in death on October 2, 2023.

He served in the United States Navy from 1973-1979 with two years following in the Naval Reserves, where he was enlisted as an intelligence officer and electronic warfare technologist on the USS Talbot FFG-4 First Ship and USS Ellison DD-864 Second Ship.

He was an Elder at Westminster Presbyterian Church, Boy Scout Leader and member of Brazeau Historical Society.
