Anna "Ann" Rose Steimle Hinton, 87, of Jackson, passed away January 11, 2026, surrounded by her loving family.

Ann was born on May 28, 1938, in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, the daughter of Edward and Arvella Dumey Steimle. She graduated from Cape Girardeau Catholic High School in 1956. In 1957, she married Gerald "Jerry" Hinton, and they shared 66 years of marriage.

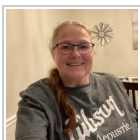
