Anneliese Pincksten, 89, of Fairdealing, Missouri, died Saturday, March 14, 2015, at the Lutheran Home in Cape Girardeau, with her husband at her side. She was born in 1926 in Weiden, Germany, to Rudolph and Stephanie Fenzel Schroeder. She and Omer S. Pincksten were married Feb. 5, 1955, at Frohna, Missouri. Quick of Citrus Heights, California; a brother, Karl Schroeder of Weiden; a grandson, Stephen Quick of Pueblo, Colorado; and a great-grandson, Weston D. Quick.
