Anthony Riley "Tony" Schuch, 76, of Cape Girardeau was received into the loving arms of God Monday, July 7, 2014 at Life Care Center of Cape Girardeau. He was born March 30, 1938 in Washington, D.C., to Edward A. and Nan Ellen Riley Schuch. He and Annette Wallace were married July 9, 1967 at Kennett, Mo. Tony received a Bachelor degree in Education from Southeast Missouri State University and a Masters in Art Education at Missouri University in Columbia. He first taught in the communities of Sullivan, Caruthersville, and Kennett, Mo. for 10 years. He then taught 26 years in the Cape Girardeau Public Schools System. He retired in 1995. He was a member of Lynwood Baptist Church for 18 years and formerly First Baptist Church for 27 years. He was also a member of MSTA and past member of SEMO Council on the Arts. Tony's hobby was painting, mainly landscapes. He also painted a portrait of Kurt Warner, that Kurt signed. As a prolific painter he shared his art in many ways, donating to family, friends, charities and other organizations. Survivors include his wife, Annette Schuch of Cape Girardeau; daughter, Laura Schuch of Cabot, Ark., brother, John Hunter Schuch of Santa Rosa, Calif.; cousins, Margie (Richard) Straka of Magnolia, Texas, the Paul Mueller, Jr. family, as well as other cousins; and two nieces.
