Arthur Anton Horky, 96, of Cape Girardeau, passed away Monday, November 7, 2011 at the Missouri Veteran's Home in Cape Girardeau. Art was born September 10, 1915 in Omaha, Nebraska, son of Mary Barbara Kremlacek and Louis B. Horky. He married Arlene Marie Johannes May 10, 1941. she preceded him in death April 1995. in 1941 Art served in the Army-Signal Corp in World War II and was at Omaha Beach. Art and Arlene moved to Cape Girardeau in 1950 where he worked for Southwestern Bell until 1979. He was a member of the VFW and the Pioneers. He enjoyed gardening, woodworking, traveling, bowling, fishing and square dancing. In 1995 Art began spending summers in Boulder, Colo. with his daughter. He played on a softball team until the age of 93. He also participated in the Bolder Boulder 10 K and received gold medals in his age division of 90 and 91.
