Billie T. Sheppard, Jr., 58, of Jackson, Mo., died Saturday, September 3, 2011 at Southeast Missouri Hospital in Cape Girardeau. He was born December 7, 1952 in Cape Girardeau, to Billie True and Ruth Luella Langston Sheppard, Sr. He served in the Navy during the Vietnam War. Billie was a concrete truck driver and firefighter in Kansas City, Mo. He spent 19 years in Kansas City and moved back to Cape Girardeau in 2008. He was a member of V.F.W.
