Carole Hirsch Folwell, 69, of Cape Girardeau, died Thursday, October 7, 2010 at Ratliff Care Center in Cape Girardeau. She was born July 18, 1941 in Cape Girardeau, the daughter of Ralph L. and Laverne Moore Hirsch. She and John D. Folwell were married in August 1968 in Alton, Ill. Carole was a graduate of Central High School. She attended Southeast Missouri State University two years and Methodist Hospital Nursing School in Memphis, Tenn. three years where she received an R.N. degree. She worked as an R.N. in Texas, was an instructor at St. Luke's Hospital in St. Louis, and worked in the E.R. at St. Joseph's Hospital in Alton, Ill. She later worked as a tax preparer for H&R Block in Alton. In January 1999 she and her husband moved to Cape Girardeau. Carole was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Cape Girardeau. Before moving to Cape Girardeau, she had been active at the College Avenue Presbyterian Church in Alton and the Collingwood Presbyterian Church in Toledo, Ohio.
