Colin Brett McLain, 25, of Washington, DC, formally of Cape Girardeau died July 6, 2010 in Mongolia. He was born March 22, 1985 in Cape Girardeau, MO to Randy Ivan and Judy Lynne Graden McLain. He was a 2003 graduate of Cape Central High School, and graduated from Carleton College in 2007 with a BA in International Relations and Political Economy. In 2009 he began law school at the Washington Law School at American University, in Washington, DC. Colin had a great love of reading. He traveled extensively visiting China, Thailand, Korea, Switzerland, and France, and also managed to make an appearance on the game show Jeopardy on March 23, 2010. The summer of 2010 Colin was completing an eight week internship with the Legal Advisor to the President of Mongolia. He was a member of Abbey Road Christian Church, the National Society Sons of the American Revolution, and obtained the rank of Eagle Scout. Colin also loved to spend time with his family and friends.
