



## Daniel G. Penrod

January 25, 1932 - February 15, 2020

Daniel G. Penrod, 88, of Cape Girardeau, passed away Saturday, February 15, 2020.

He was born January 25, 1932 in Murphysboro, Illinois to the late George Washington and Laura (Graff) Penrod.

Dan was a graduate of Murphysboro High School. He was trained as a painter by his father. Around 1956 he moved to Cape Girardeau and started Paramount Painting Company. He worked for Travelodge in the mid 80's and 90's. He built homes around the Cape Girardeau area from the early 70's until 2016.

He was a charter member of La Croix United Methodist Church where he was very active, serving on several committees which included the building committee. He was member of the Harold O. Grauel #672 Lodge, was an avid Cardinal baseball fan and loved to play golf. He enjoyed cooking, grilling, loved Jesus and enjoyed being with his family and friends.

His loving survivors include his wife, Terri Penrod; 4 children, Pam (Jay) Campbell of Kansas City, MO, Randy (Retta) Penrod of Murphysboro, IL, Doug (Susan) Penrod of Troy, IL and Kim (Alan) Wengert of Cape Girardeau; 7 grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren and 3 nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; brother, George Washington Penrod Jr.; sisters, Celestine Yates, Doris Bloodworth and Prudence Huppert. Visitation will be Sunday, February 16, 2020 from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. at Ford and Sons Mt. Auburn Chapel.
