David Leo Davidson of Cape Girardeau died Saturday, March 7, 2026, at his home.

He was born on August 23, 1943, in Galesburg, IL, son of Finis Leo and Bernedith Virginia Davidson. He and Teresa Kirby Davidson were married April 3, 1965, in Cape Girardeau. After Teresa's passing in 2003 he married his surviving wife, Rosemary Cowan, in 2022.

After graduating from Cape Central High School and serving his country in the National Guard, David began a 45-year career as a brick and stone mason. He took tremendous pride in his craft, and the legacy of his work lives on in countless public/commercial buildings and residential homes throughout the Cape Girardeau community, including Kent Library, the Boat House, and the Federal Courthouse.

David was an avid fisherman, card and game player with dominoes being his favorite in his later years. He served the community by coaching youth baseball and basketball for years, volunteering at Meals on Wheels, and catching enough crappie to serve hundreds at his church fish fries. He also enjoyed spending time with family and especially enjoyed spoiling his grandchildren and great grandchildren with his generosity. He was a member of Lynwood Baptist Church and cherished his church family.
