We regretfully announce the passing of David Bryant Gollither, of Cape Girardeau Missouri. David was born to Joe and Dorita Howard Gollither on April 7, 1950. He sadly passed away on April 28, 2022 after a battle with cancer. David grew up in Cape Girardeau and was a graduate of Southeast Missouri State University.
