David W. Heuer, 79, reached the end of his earthly journey on Monday, January 26, 2025, at St. Francis Hospital surrounded by family.

He was born on August 10, 1946, in Cape, the son of Willard R. and Marjorie VanGilder Heuer.

He began his own family on September 24, 1966, when he married Donna Wessell at Zion Lutheran Church in Gordonville. Together they raised their children and enjoyed their grandchildren.

Dave worked as a farmer, salesman at Heuer Sons Implement, and retired from Wiethop Truck Sales in Cape Girardeau. He served in the Missouri National Guard from 1966 to 1974.

He had a special love for bib overalls and Tennessee Walking horses and spent many hours either riding, driving, horse camping, or just talking about them. He also collected and tinkered with his Farmall tractors, and enjoyed camping and side by side riding.

He was a lifetime member of Hanover Lutheran Church. He was especially proud that his great-grandson is the sixth generation of Heuers at Hanover.

Dave is survived by his wife of nearly 60 years, Donna; a son, Jeff (Sara) Heuer and a daughter, Kristi (Chester) Seyer; five grandchildren, Clint (Torey) Heuer, Brett (Teagan) Heuer, Ethan Seyer, Chelsea Seyer, and Taylor Seyer; one great-grandson, Emmett Heuer; and a brother-in-law, Doug (Susan) Wessell.

He is preceded in death by his father and mother, and Donna's parents, Walter (Maude) Wessell and step-mother, Lola Wessell.
