Diane D. Duncan, 58 of Cape Girardeau, passed away Thursday, Oct. 24, 2019 at Southeast Hospital.

She was born December 5, 1960 in Cape Girardeau to Roscoe Matthew and Georgia (Duncan) Dannenmueler.

Diane spent a total of 40 years in the banking industry, the last 15 years of which was with Alliance Bank in Cape Girardeau where she held the title of Assistant Vice President. She was also a longtime member of the Cape Girardeau Chamber of Commerce and was heavily involved in many local events.

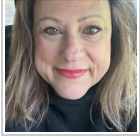
