Dorothy King, 78, of Cape Girardeau, died Monday, Jan. 10, 2011, at Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau. She was born August 14, 1932, in Chaffee, Mo., to Tony and Alma Heuring Kielhafner. She and Louie King were married Nov. 24, 1955, in Kelso, Mo. Dorothy worked at the Chaffee Shoe Factory, then the Lowenbaum dress factory in Cape Girardeau for 15 years. She then worked with Procter & Gamble in Cape Girardeau for 21 years, retiring in 1996. She volunteered at Saint Francis Medical Center for 13 years and was Auxiliary Person of the Year for 2004 and 2005. She was a member of St. Vincent de Paul Church. Survivors include her husband, Louie King, of Cape Girardeau; two sisters, Alene (Louis) Eftink and Lillian Emmons, both of Scott City; one son, Richard (Patricia) King of San Antonio; and two grandchildren, Michael and Meghan King.
