Bishop D.W. Randol, 87, of Cape Girardeau went to his reward on Saturday, April 3, 2021. He was born November 9, 1933 at home in East McClure, Illinois to Earl and Mary Randol.

Visitation will be 4 to 7 pm on Wednesday April 7, followed by a Celebration of Life at 7 pm at Calvary United Pentocostal Church, 581 Broadridge Drive Jackson, Missouri, where he has been a respected and honored member since his retirement in 2003. Rev. Ronnie Brown will officiate. Entombment will be in Cape County Memorial Park Mausoleum, next to his loving wife of 52 years. You may join the family at 11 am, Thursday at the church for the procession. In over 60 years of ministry, he led five congregations, having started two of them.
