Dr. Dudley G. Ruopp, 92, of Cape Girardeau, MO, passed away Wednesday, December 2, 2009 at the Missouri Veteran's Home in Cape Girardeau, MO. He was born April 10, 1917 in New York, NY to John Ruopp and Jane Long Ruopp. Dr. Ruopp was married to Imelda Carron on January 13, 1946 in Bloomsdale, Missouri. She preceeded him in death on March 21, 2009. He was a member of St. Vincent De Paul Catholic Church. Dr. Ruopp served in the Army in WWII in the Pacific theater. Dr. Ruopp graduated from Logan Chiropractic College in 1939 then moved to Cape where he opened his practice in 1946 he operated it till retiring in 1986. Dr. Ruopp was a former President of the Kiwanis club along with being the Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus. He was a member of the South East Missouri State Chiropractic Association, a volunteer Juvenile probation officer for over four years, and served for the City of Cape planning and zoning committee for twenty five years.
