Edgar A. "Edro" Esicar, Jr., 85, of Cape Girardeau, passed away Tuesday, November 22, 2011 at St. Francis Medical Center. He was born April 11, 1926 in Saint Louis, Mo. to Edgar A. and Bessie R. Sherman Esicar. He and his dearest friend Virginia "Dolly" Schlue were companions for 62 years. Edro was a Merchant Marine in World War II, and served in the Army during the Korean War where he was awarded three Bronze Service Stars. He owned and operated Esicar's Old Hickory Smoke House with his father, brother, and nephew from 1952 to 1991. He was past exalted ruler of the Elk's from 1967 to 1968, a life member of the VFW Post #3838, an avid golfer and long time member of Kimbeland County Club where he recorded a double-eagle before the renovations. Survivors include a nephew, Blake Esicar (Janet) of Cape Girardeau; a niece, Janice Halter of Cape Girardeau; sister-in-law, Georgia Schatte Esicar of Cape Girardeau; dearest friend, Virginia "Dolly" Schlue of Cape Girardeau; great-nephew, Mike Larkin (Cindy) of Ironton, Mo.; great-niece, Jessica Halter Powell (Jim) of Chicago, Ill.
