Edith Marie Mehrle Eggers, 87, of Jackson, passed away peacefully on Saturday June 27, 2015 at her home.

Edith was born November 8, 1927 in Cape Girardeau, the daughter of Werner and Zetta Unger Mehrle. On September 29, 1950 Edith married William M. Eggers. He preceded her in death on May 9, 1996.
