Eleanor L. Nenninger, 85, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at her home.

She was born October 24, 1934 in Leopold, Missouri to Louis and Mary Stoverink Holzum.

She and Eugene Nenninger were married June 13, 1953 at Leopold, Missouri. He preceded her in death on April 27, 1998.

Eleanor was a transport technician at St. Francis Medical Center for 27 years.

She was a member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church and the St. Vincent C.C.W. She also served as a volunteer at St. Francis Medical Center.

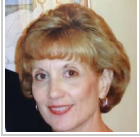
