



Elizabeth Ann Anderson

June 7, 1939 - April 9, 2018

Surrounded by family members, Elizabeth Ann (Crowell) Anderson, 78, of Morley, Missouri went to be with the Lord on Monday, April 9, 2018 from St. Francis Hospital in Cape Girardeau. Ann was the beloved wife of Bill Anderson (Cuzin Carl) and cherished matriarch of an extended family of loved ones and friends.

Born June 7, 1939 in Oklahoma, Ann was the daughter of Raymond Lee and Marguerite Eugenia (Havins) Crowell, and older sister to Ray Crowell of Idabel, Oklahoma. She was valedictorian of her high school class at graduation in 1957. She married Bill R. Anderson on April 6, 1962.

Ann worked alongside her husband as his business partner in their companies which included Canadian Valley Aerial Application, Anderson Flying Service Pipeline Patrol and Pure Country, C106 KWKZ radio station. She was an excellent bookkeeper and wordsmith.

Known to many as "Miss Ann," she was a true southern lady and a sweet, selfless woman who lived for her family. She was never the one in the spotlight, always the one supporting the dreams of others. She loved listening to her husband and daughters on the radio, and her youngest daughter and her daughter-in-law sing and perform. She enjoyed watching her son ride horses and rodeo, and her oldest daughter report the news. She cheered for

her grandchildren at sports and school activities and was amazed at her great granddaughter's budding talent at playing violin. She was the consummate fan.

Ann was an avid reader, and exceptional seamstress. She enjoyed traveling in their RV and was drawn to southern and southwestern culture and collectables, especially blue bonnets, magnolias and cacti. She had many pets through the years and adored her little poodle, Gus.
