ElLouise Lillian (nee Boldenow) Kollmann of Cape Girardeau, MO. formerly of Centralia, Missouri, passed away Saturday . May 7, 2016 at the Lutheran Home.

She was born on February 14, 1922 in Chokio, Minnesota, to Henry and Louise (Hoger) Boldenow. The midwife presented ElLouise to her father saying, " Henry, you have a valentine ! "
