Emma Laverne Sparks Olson, 88, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri passed away Sunday, December 24, 2023 at her home.

Emma was born February 26, 1935 in Lamar, Arkansas, daughter of Thomas Frank and Augusta Theresa Christine Doerr Sparks.

Emma graduated from high school in New Madrid County in 1953 and from Southeast Missouri State University in 1965 with a B.S. in Education. She then completed graduate work in Special Education and Behavioral Science at University of California, Los Angeles. She also received a N.D.E.A. Grant to do study and research at University of Illinois. She pursued a career in teaching in Michigan, California and Illinois. After 34 years of teaching, she retired from Wheaton, Illinois School District. Most of her career was spent teaching disabled and behavior disorder students.

Emma was an ardent, lifelong conservative and active member and supporter of the Republican party.

She was confirmed as a member of the First Baptist Church in 1947. In 1972 she married John Edwin Olson, in Elmhurst, Illinois. He passed away May 4, 2001.
