March 24, 1931 - January 2, 2016

Frank C. Bertrand, age 84, of Cape Girardeau Missouri, beloved husband of Martha Hopper Bertrand, entered into eternal rest on January 2, 2016.

Frank was born March 24, 1931 in Jackson Missouri, son of Frank C. and Zetta Essner Bertrand.

He served in the United States Army from January 22, 1952 until October 21, 1953. He served most of his military time in Korea and was honorably discharged as Sergeant First Class in 1953. Following his military service, he went to work on tow boats on the Mississippi River. In 1987, he retired as a River Boat Captain from Cargill Carriers of St. Paul, Minnesota.

Surviving are his wife, Martha, one daughter: Jaynee (Ray) Juneau of Cape Girardeau, five sons: Stephen (Kathy) Bertrand of Washington, Missouri, Dennis (Chris) Bertrand of Atoka, Tennessee, Chuck (Evelyn) Bertrand, David (Kathy) and Tom (Cindy) Bertrand, all of Cape Girardeau, Missouri.
