Gene H. Patterson, 73, of Cape Girardeau, died Tuesday, May 8, 2012 at St. Francis Medical Center. He was born November 15, 1938 in Hayti, Mo. to G. W. and Christine Homer Patterson. He and Yvonne DeLisle were married Monday, March 30, 1964 at Portageville, Mo. Gene was a graduate of Hayti High School. He was President and CEO of River Eagle Distributing.
