Georgia Marie Howe, 95, of Cape Girardeau, died peacefully May 14th, 2023 at The Arbors at Capetown.

Georgia was born February 12, 1928 in Cape Girardeau to George and Marie GreaserDannenmueller.

She and Dallas "Gene" Howe were married June 22, 1948 in Cape Girardeau. He preceded her in death on August 16, 1995.

Georgia was a lifetime member of St. Mary's Cathedral parish, where she was honored in 2009 as a Distinguished Graduate from St. Mary's Cathedral school. She was also a former sacristan, a strong supporter of Notre Dame High School, a former member of the Red Hat Society and a longtime volunteer with Meals on Wheels.
