Gerald L. Stevens, 72, of Marble Hill, formerly of Cape Girardeau, passed away Friday, June 29, 2012, at Saint Francis Medical Center. Gerald was born Dec. 8, 1939, in Cape Girardeau, to Charles M. and Glenda A. Bridges Stevens. He was a graduate of Southeast Missouri State University with a bachelor's degree in business administration. Gerald married Shirley A. Hahn on Aug. 16, 1959, in De Soto, Mo. He was vice president of Colonial Federal Savings & Loan from 1967 to 1989. He was the owner/operator of H&R Block Tax Service in Perryville, Mo., and Ste. Genevieve, Mo., from 1992 to present. He was an enrolled agent with the IRS. Gerald was a member of Centenary United Methodist Church in Cape Girardeau. He was a former member of the Cape Girardeau Jaycees and the Cape Girardeau Optimist Club.
