Gordon Leon Morgan, 78, of Cape Girardeau, passed away Tuesday, September 20, 2022 at his home.

He was born January 17, 1944 in Morley, Missouri, to Reece and Sylvia Knotts Morgan.

Gordon and Fawn Fornkohl were married June 30, 1979, in Cape Girardeau.

He served honorably in the United States Army, stationed in Fort Hood, Texas from 1965-68. He was awarded the Marksman (Rifle M-14) and Sharpshooter (Carbine) medals.

He excelled in restoring vehicles, boats and tractors.

Captain Morgan was proudly employed by the Cape Girardeau Fire Department for 31 years.

Gordon was an avid outdoorsman with a passion for all things, including hunting and fishing and also being a lifetime member of the Cape Girardeau Elks Lodge.
