Henry "Hank" Buchheit, 80, of Cape Girardeau, died Saturday, April 24, 2010 at Southeast Missouri Hospital. He was born December 15, 1929 in St. Louis, the son of Albert Joseph and Leneta Loretta Hotop Buchheit. He and Ada Lee Eftink were married June 11, 1955 at Guardian Angel Church in Oran, Mo. She died November 10, 1999. Hank served during the Koren War, first in the Air Force and then in the Army. He moved to Cape Girardeau from Old Appleton in 1948. He was a member of St. Mary Cathedral, Knights of Columbus Council 1111, United Commercial Travelers, T.P.A. and V.F.W. Post 3838. Hank worked for Winnelson, formerly N.O. Nelson, 38 years. His greatest joys were fishing and being with his dog, Mitzi. Survivors include three daughters, Cindy (Greg) Lowes of Cape Girardeau, Ruby (John) Cox of Desloge, Mo., Tammy (Steve) Lunsford of Zalma, Mo.; one sister, Aurelia "Mic" Weiss of Creve Coeur, Mo.; six grandchildren, Joseph, Jason, Jennifer, Jessica, Angela, and Amy; ten great-grandchildren with one on the way; and several nieces & nephews.
