Eugene Borchelt, 81, of Egypt Mills died Friday, Oct. 1, 2010, at Southeast Missouri Hospital in Cape Girardeau. He was born Jan. 22, 1929, in Egypt Mills to Herbert A. and Barbara Exler Borchelt.
