Herbert William "Schimmel" Rellergert, 89, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Friday, November 7, 2014 at Missouri Veteran's Home in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. He was born August 3, 1925 in Old Appleton, Missouri to August Andrew and Louise Mary Trapp Rellergert. He and Mary Chaffin were married May 24, 1958 at St. Joseph Church in Apple Creek, Missouri. Herb served in the Navy during World War II and the Korean War. He joined the Navy on November 11, 1943 and served on the USS Mercy hospital ship. He was honorably discharged on April 22, 1946 and then re-enlisted for the Korean War in 1952. Herb's first job was working alongside his father in the Old Appleton Brewery. After the Navy, he worked for Anheuser-Busch in St. Louis and eventually became a truck driver for Missouri Distributors where he retired in 1986. He was a member of St. Mary Cathedral and V.F.W. Post 3838. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, taking walks and scenic drives, and visiting the bridge at Old Appleton. He was a big fan of the St. Louis Cardinals.
