



Howard Andrew Marberry

November 23, 1920 - June 10, 2015

Howard Andrew Marberry, 94, of Jackson, Missouri, died Wednesday, June 10, 2015 at Southeast Hospital in Cape Girardeau, MO.

He was born November 23, 1920 in Clarkton, MO to the late Andrew Jackson and Effie Belver Marberry. He married Vera Mae Hensley on October 21, 1939 and together they raised a family in Cape Girardeau. He served his country honorably during WWII as a member of the U.S. Army from October 1944 to January 1946.

Howard was employed by International Shoe Co. in Cape Girardeau for 26 years, and later was employed by Avon Corp. in Morton Grove, IL for 19 years. He and Vera retired back to Cape Girardeau in 1985 where they were lifelong members of Cape First church.

Survivors include a son, Richard (Marlian) Marberry of Kuttawa, KY; daughters, Mary Ann (Robert) Moore of Cape, Valerie (David) Allen of Jackson; 10 grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, and 9 great-great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 72 years; his parents; one sister, three brothers and two sons.

Visitation will be Saturday, June 13, 2015 from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. at Ford & Sons Mt. Auburn Funeral Home. Funeral service will follow at 11:00 a.m. at the funeral home with Pastor Rick Hensley officiating.
