Hubert H. Bachmann, 78, of Cape Girardeau, Mo. died Thursday, April 16, 2009 at The Lutheran Home in Cape Girardeau, Mo. He was born September 14, 1930, in Crosstown, Mo., the son of Henry M. and Hedwig C. "Hattie" Oster Bachmann. He and Jean Rathert were married on November 30, 1957 at St. Andrew Lutheran Church in St. Louis, Mo. She died February 21, 1998.
