Ina Mae Faulconer, 97, of Perkins, Missouri died Wednesday, January 21, 2026 at her sister's home.

She was born May 7, 1928 in Messler, Missouri to Joseph Pinkney and Dadie Ruthetta London Kennedy.

She and Ernest Wesley Faulconer were married May 8, 1948 at Pocahontas, Arkansas. He preceded her in death on September 9, 2007.
