Irma Jean Dinwiddie, 95, of Cape Girardeau died Thursday, December 29, 2022 at her home.

She was born on March 15, 1927 to Thurston and Nellie (Miller) Amick of rural Glasgow, Missouri.

She and Donald Dinwiddie were married March 15, 1950 after he graduated from Central Methodist College. He preceded her in death on February 19, 2005.
