Isaac H. Driskell, 88, of Cape Girardeau, MO, died Tuesday, April 20, 2010 at Chateau Girardeau Health Center, The Gardens, in Cape Girardeau, MO. He was born Friday, October 28, 1921 in Perkins, MO., son of Robert and Sophia Myers Driskell . He and Katie Elizabeth Mott Driskell were married Wednesday, June 4, 1947 at Arbor, Missouri. He was a member of Gospel Assembly Church in Anna, Illinois. Isaac served in the U.S. Army from 1942 to 1946 where he was involved in the North African Campaign and the invasion of Sicily. He was a lifetime member VFW Post 3838. He was employed by Don Thiele Concrete Finishing from 1956 to 1969. He then started his own company, Driskell Cement Finishing Company in 1970 where he retired in 1997.
