Barbara Louise Cathcart, 87, of Cape Girardeau passed away peacefully in her home on the morning of Friday, March 6, 2020. Her husband, Rev. Jack Lee Cathcart, 87, passed away peacefully later that same day and joined his bride in their new heavenly home.

Barbara Cathcart was born on May 5, 1932 in Harrisburg, Illinois to Louis and Helen Gidcumb Jackson.

They were married on March 29, 1951 in Springfield, Illinois, and would have celebrated 69 years of marriage this month.
