James A. Irwin, 87, of Twin Oaks, Missouri died Tuesday, March 25, 2025 at his home.

He was born April 30, 1937 in Perkins, Missouri to Walter G. and Dora Haney Irwin.

He and Thelma Owen were married in 1959.

He attended school in Perkins and Bell City, graduating from high school in 1955.

He worked in Saint Louis for two years before moving to Cape Girardeau to work for Adams Dairy. He was a self employed distributor for Adams Dairy for six years, before becoming a contractor for the United States Postal Service, retiring in 2004. He was awarded the Eagle Spirit Award for Excellence by the National Mail Transportation Purchasing.
