James Michael Lloyd, 67, of Cape Girardeau, died Tuesday September 10, 2013 at his home. He was born March 24, 1946 to Charles W., and Helen M. Lloyd (Gerecke) in Cape Girardeau, MO. He grew up in Malden, MO and Graduated from Malden High School. He spent his summers in Cape Girardeau, MO on the farm of his Grandparent's Louis and Frieda Gerecke.
