He was a graduate of Southeast Missouri State University and a charter member of St. Andrew Lutheran Church.

Jim was a good athlete and golfer. He won the Member Guest Golf Tournament at the Cape Country Club twice. He had a hole-in-one on #6 at Kimbeland Country Club. His golf handicap was 2.

Jim is survived by his wife; daughter, Christy (Ron) Brooks and son, Randy (Sarah) Stovall; grandchildren, Sam, Jack and Eleri Brooks, Reese, Paige, Finn and Eve Stovall.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents, several cousins and loved ones.
