Lt. Col. Jerry W. Twaddell, (ret.) 73, of Cape Girardeau, MO died Wednesday, November 27, 2013 at Jackson Manor in Jackson, MO. He was born March 10, 1940 in Fordyce, AR to Clinton O. and Georgia Moseley Twaddell. He was the salutatorian of his High School graduation class in 1958. He and Mary Jane Lumsden were married August 18, 1962 at Essex, Missouri. Mr. Twaddell graduated from the University of Missouri in 1963 with a major in Political Science. He was then commissioned into the United States Air Force as a Second Lieutenant. He completed pilot training in 1964 and went on to teach other Air Force Pilots. He served two tours in Vietnam as a fighter pilot. After returning to the states, Jerry continued to train other pilots. In 1974, he received a Masters of Art in Education from Pepperdine University. He retired from the Air Force as a Lieutenant Colonel in 1985 at the age of 45. He spent the next several years as a skilled artisan. He was a member of Centenary United Methodist Church. Survivors include his wife, Mary Jane Twaddell of Cape Girardeau, MO. Daughter, Heather (Scott) Powers of Grand Rapids, MI. Son, Clinton L. (Kristina) Twaddell of Bloomfield, MO.
