November 16, 1928 - July 30, 2017

Jessie Mae Blattel Gulley, 88, passed peacefully into eternal life on Sunday, July 30, 2017, at Parkside Manor in Columbia, MO with family by her side, bidding her farewell.

She was born on November 16, 1928 in Sturdivant, MO to the Reverend Homer Campbell and Myrtle Effie Kinder Campbell. artists were Marty Robbins and Elvis. With her father being a General Baptist minister, she had a love for gospel music she shared with her children, as well.
