Jim Baylor, 75, of Jackson, Missouri died Wednesday, July 27, 2016 at Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau.

He was born May 3, 1941 in Cape Girardeau to Eldon and Elizabeth Rhyne Baylor.

He and Judy Valleroy were married Friday, March 11, 1966 at Southside Baptist Church in Cape Girardeau.

Jim was a 1960 graduate of College High. He was one of the first Eagle Scouts from Troop 5 and was a member of the Order of the Arrow.

He served in the Air Force during the Cuban Missile Crisis and Vietnam War.

He was a salesman for 50 years for various companies, but retired from Reppert's Office Supplies.

He was a two-time past commander and served in the Color Guard of V.F.W. Post 3838 where he was a lifetime member. He belonged to American Legion Post 63. He was also a lifetime member of 509th Bomb Wing Veterans Association.

Survivors include his wife, Judy Baylor of Jackson; daughter, Susan (Bryan) Hartnagel of Columbia, Missouri; and two grandchildren, Brooke and Kaitlyn Hartnagel.

He was preceded in death by his parents; daughter, Melissa Baylor; and brother, Eldon "Sonny" Baylor.
