March 16, 1936 - August 11, 2025

John Francis Knaup, 89, of Jackson, Missouri passed away Monday, August 11, 2025 at the Lutheran Home.

He was born March 16, 1936 in Cape Girardeau son of John and Clara Stehr Knaup.

He graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1954. He attended Southeast Missouri State University for two years, then graduated with an agriculture degree from University of Missouri at Columbia in 1962.

He served in the United States Navy from 1955 to 1957.

He owned Knaup Greenhouses in Jackson, Missouri till 1998 when he retired. He was known for his mum patch, spring flowers and tomato plants.

He was a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Jackson, where he served as an usher and head of Social Ministry with his wife. John and his wife, Ann won Notre Dame's Bob Miller award for outstanding contribution to the booster club. He was involved with Saint Francis Medical Center Perpetual Adoration for 25 years and made Cursillo. He was a member of Cape Jaycees and Knights of Columbus in Cape and Jackson. John and Billy Joe Swan coached basketball at Immaculate Conception

during the 70's till 1981.

He and Dolores Ann Jarosik were married June 10, 1961 at St Mary's Cathedral in Cape Girardeau.
