Joseph Lee "Joe Fig" Figliolo 74 yrs of age of Cape Girardeau, passed away Saturday, February 20, 2016 at his home.

Joe was born April 8, 1941, in Nettleton, Arkansas.

Joe moved to Cape Girardeau to raise his young family. He worked for Skinner Plumbing and Heating as an apprentice plumber; for Paramount Liquor Company as a delivery driver; and for Cape Central Airways on the flight line while building up his own construction company, Figliolo Construction, Inc., which he operated until 1975.

He then worked for the City of Cape Girardeau as the on-site inspector during the construction of the city owned swimming pool at Central High School (now Central Junior High), following which he worked as a Code Inspector for the city until 1986.

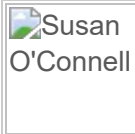
