JUANITA MARIE MOORE, AGE 95, OF KELSO, MO, DIED FRIDAY, JULY 16, 2010 AT THE LUTHERAN HOME IN CAPE GIRARDEAU, MO. SHE WAS BORN JULY 26, 1914 IN CAIRO, IL TO WILLIAM OSCAR AND JESSIE MARIE PHELPS HOLDERFIELD. SHE AND ROBERT CLEO MOORE OF MOUNDS, IL WERE MARRIED ON SEPTEMBER 15, 1934 IN JONESBORO, IL. HE DIED DECEMBER 16TH, 1954. JUANITA LIVED MOST OF HER LIFE IN CAIRO, IL WHERE SHE WAS A MEMBER OF THE TIGERT MEMORIAL CHURCH. SHE GRADUATED FROM CAIRO HIGH SCHOOL IN THE CLASS OF 1933. JUANITA BECAME A LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE AND WORKED MANY YEARS AT THE SOUTHERN SEVEN HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN CAIRO, IL UNTIL HER RETIREMENT IN 1985. IN 1995, JUANITA MOVED TO KELSO, MO. TO MAKE HER HOME WITH HER DAUGHTER AND SON-IN-LAW TONI AND TROY WILBURN. AFTER MOVING TO MISSOURI, SHE BECAME AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE BROADWAY UNITED METHODIST CHURCH IN SCOTT CITY AND PERFORMED MANY HOURS OF VOLUNTEER SERVICE WITH THE CAPE GIRARDEAU SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER SURVIVORS INCLUDE THREE DAUGHTERS, TONITA AND HUSBAND TROY WILBURN OF KELSO, MO; RITA AND HUSBAND BILLY MANGRUM OF GORDON VILLE, TX; KAREN AND HUSBAND WILLIAM GRIFFITH OF CHAFFEE, MO; A SON, ROBERT MOORE AND WIFE LORETTA OF GAINSVILLE, TX; 11 GRANDCHILDREN, 17 GREAT-GRANDCHILDREN, A GREAT-GREAT GRANDCHILD AND 5
