Julia Ann "Judy" Thompson Litzelfelner, 89, lifelong resident of Jackson, Missouri passed away peacefully surrounded by family Wednesday, January 10, 2024 at the Lutheran Home in Cape Girardeau.

She was born September 30, 1934 in Fruitland, Missouri to Sylvester and Anna McDonald Thompson

Judy was a graduate of Jackson High School.

She and Jack Litzelfelner Sr. were married in 1953 at First Presbyterian Church in Jackson. They were married for 63 years before his passing on June 5, 2017.

She was a homemaker and a loving and devoted wife and mother. After her children were raised, Judy took up painting and became a talented skilled artist.

She was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Jackson, where she volunteered. She also volunteered at Girl Scouts and the Jackson History Center.

She spent her last four months at the Lutheran Home in Cape Girardeau, where she was quickly loved by residents and staff.
